

News from The Gamebird Foundation (TGBF) that brings you PHEASANTS AND THE NEW RED-LEGGED PARTRIDGE. We are right in the middle of raising around 8,000 baby pheasant chicks to adulthood and releasing them into some of the best habitat we can find in our beautiful region. Little Canyon Shooting Sports just hatched out our Red-Leg eggs that TGBF purchased with multiple donations. Out of the 2,100 eggs, they hatched out 1,300 baby chicks! We now have them in brooders and the members of TGBF will raise them until they are 10-12 weeks old to be released in several small groups of 10 to 15 around the Clearwater Region.

TGBF can only do this with the support of membership and the community who donate a little time, money or materials to help build the brooders. This also helps buy the feed that it takes to raise the birds to adulthood so we can release them for the viewing of the general public. The Gamebird Foundation is a 501c3 non-profit corporation. When you donate for tax relief, you help us raise and produce more birds for your viewing pleasure, the enjoyment of our youth, and our hunting friends. We need your help.
